


# Come Join Our Youth/Mentor Program!

# Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS): Quick Sheet for Parents

## WHAT IS PBIS?

PBIS way of thinking:

- 🐾 I am Respectful.
- 🐾 I am Responsible.
- 🐾 I am Safe.

## BEHAVIOR CHART

Explains the behavioral expectations in each area of the school.

## RECOGNITION CARDS

At AES students earn Golden Tickets for good behavior. When goals are met, students participate in celebrations.



## BEHAVIOR TRACKING SHEETS

Help track when students misbehave. Even with clear expectations, frequent teaching of behavior, children will sometimes still misbehave. Discipline issues are divided into majors and minors.

- **Majors:** behaviors that result in office time. Parents/guardians will be notified.
- **Minors:** behaviors disruptive to learning that are handled by a teacher/staff member.

\*If a child receives 3 minors in 4 weeks, it becomes a major. The principal will address the behaviors and notify parents/guardians.



## PBIS AT ALGOMA ELEMENTARY HELPS STUDENTS BY:

- 1) Having clear and consistent expectations (Behavior Chart).
- 2) Teaching students the school expectations.
- 3) Rewarding good behavior (Golden Tickets).
- 4) Tracking student behavior that does not follow the expectations (Behavior Tracking Sheet).

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As a parent, you are a part of the Title I team!

More than any teacher or school, your involvement can boost your child's achievement. By taking an active role in Title I, you'll show your child:

- How important he or she is to you.
- How important education is to you.
- That you and the child are a team.
