**\$10,000 Scholarships!**

**For high school students pursuing an agriculture field that will enhance rural communities. Scholarship recipients will receive \$10,000 over four years.**

### **Am I eligible?**

To apply for the Thomas H. Lutsey-Waseda Farms Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Current graduating senior attending a high school within 150 miles of Green Bay
- Attending an accredited 4-year college/university
  - *Students can apply if they plan on attending a 2-year technical school first to then transfer to a 4-year program as a full-time student.*
- Pursuing a career with an agriculture focus that will enhance rural communities
  - *Examples include: dairy science, animal science, agriculture engineering, veterinary medicine, agriculture economics, environmental science, agri-business*
- Minimum 3.0 high school GPA
- Minimum 19 ACT composite score
- Student with a rural or agriculture background
- Financial need as demonstrated by the FAFSA

### **How do I apply?**

Applying for the Thomas H. Lutsey-Waseda Farms Scholarship is easy:

- Complete the Online Application Form
- Submit a Personal Statement
- Submit a listing of your Extracurricular Activities
- Provide two (2) Letters of Recommendation
- Submit official high school transcripts and ACT/SAT scores
- Complete of the FAFSA and submit the SAR (Student Aid Report)

*The Thomas H. Lutsey-Waseda Farms Scholarship integrates a passion for agriculture, education and innovation, steeped in a legacy of three generations, dating back nearly 90 years. A commitment to helping make college accessible and affordable for all families, paired with creativity and a love for farming makes the Thomas H. Lutsey-Waseda Farms Scholarship an important contributor to the future of Wisconsin agriculture.*

## A Generational Commitment to Farming

Thomas H. Lutsey worked hard on the family farm beginning as a young child in 1933. As an innovative man, he was interested in how things worked and liked to create new things. One of these innovations was to make ice cream and sell it on the same trucks as the milk delivery. Continuing to evolve his ideas even further, he then created the famous and popular “paddle pops” (ice cream on a stick, dipped in chocolate and rolled in nuts). By 1946, Thomas H. Lutsey established Gold Bond Ice Cream and continued to grow and expand the business of ice cream to include novelties and other favored treats, like the Eskimo Pie. His passion for innovation led to numerous patents and continued to advance the ice cream industry. Today, Gold Bond Ice Cream is now Good Humor-Breyers and the ice cream products are sold in more than 40 states, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and Canada.

In 2008, Thomas H. Lutsey's son, Tom Lutsey, continued his father's passion for the farm and purchased land in Baileys Harbor, Wis. that is now Waseda Farms. The organic farm raises black angus and Hereford cattle, pork, chickens (both layers and fryers), turkeys and has a two-acre garden in the summer. The organic farm has a store-front on the farm in Baileys Harbor as well as a Waseda Farms Market in De Pere, Wis.

## Our Scholarship

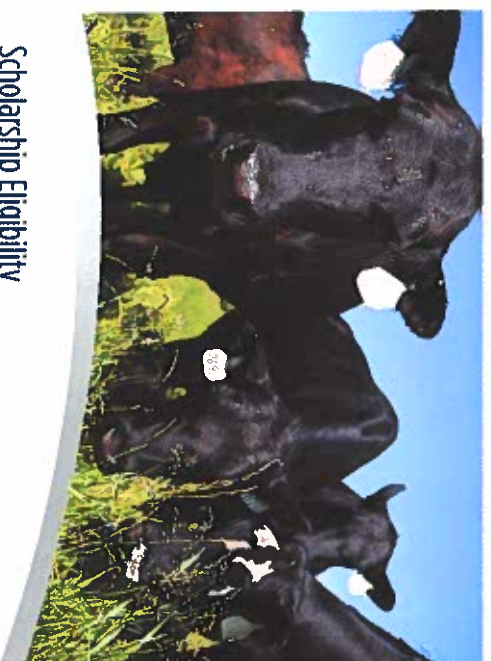
### Supporting the Future of Agriculture Through Education

Thomas H. Lutsey was a strong believer in hard work and diligence being essential to success. He wanted to help students who had a passion for agriculture and a dedication to furthering their education to advance their local community. He created the scholarship foundation to encourage students to work hard, advance their education and realize their goals.

The Thomas H. Lutsey-Waseda Farms Scholarship is a 4-year \$10,000 scholarship for students pursuing an agriculture career that will benefit our rural Wisconsin communities. Since its inception in 1986, the scholarship has awarded more than \$600,000 in gifts to over 100 college students committed to advancing the field of agriculture in northeast Wisconsin.

### The Scholarship is Awarded Over Four Years

1ST: **\$2,000** / 2ND: **\$2,250** / 3RD: **\$2,500** / 4TH: **\$3,250**
